



Magnet Eligibility Requirements for students applying for the 2023-2024 school year

Admission into a Dallas ISD Magnet school requires students to apply online at www.choose.dallasisd.org/login. You may select up to 5 choice schools with a limit of 2 magnet schools. You will need to rank your schools from 1 – 5, with 1 being the highest. Ranking your schools when applying is crucial, because the system will attempt to place your student at the highest ranked Eligible school, first. Once you receive an offer, any school ranked lower than that offer, will be automatically declined by the system. You may remain on the wait list for any higher ranked schools.

Students applying to a magnet program must meet eligibility requirements. Applicants who meet the minimum GPA **and** test score requirements are eligible to move forward to the on-campus assessment process, scheduled at the selected magnet school of choice.

Eligibility requirements:

Minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) on the most recent report card

- 80 Cumulative GPA for Talented and Gifted schools and Science and Engineering Magnet
- 75 Cumulative GPA for all other programs

Minimum STAAR, Measurement of Academic Progress (MAP) or other norm referenced test scores (refer to charts below for qualifying score requirements by grade level)
