How is our school deciding which individuals will work during intersession weeks?

Our staff completed a survey and have applied for the positions they would be interested in teaching. Our highly qualified teachers are ready to teach all our Eaglets that have been identified to receive an invitation.

On top of the core subjects (ELA, Math, Science, Social Studies), what sort of “specials” classes will be taught?

Our students will participate in project-based learning units that will include art, music, technology and physical education. Leadership will also be a major focus for sixth grade.

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If my child receives special education services, will they still be provided during intersession? How frequently?

Special Education Support for Inclusion Students: During intersession weeks, schools will provide the following staff at the following ratios to support inclusion students:

Special Education Teachers: 1 teacher for every 22 inclusion students

Special Education TAs: 1 TA for every 30 inclusion students

Special Education “Units”: During intersession weeks, special education units, such as Total Communication (TC) will be staffed as they are during the regular school day.

Other Special Education Services: Specific special education services like Occupational Therapy (OT), Physical Therapy (PT), etc. may be provided depending on which staff choose to work intersession weeks but are not guaranteed during intersession.
