







IF MY CHILD RECEIVES SPECIAL EDUCATION SERVICES, WILL THEY STILL BE PROVIDED DURING INTERSESSION? HOW FREQUENTLY?

Special Education Support for Inclusion Students: During intersession weeks, schools will provide the following staff at the following ratios to support inclusion students:

- ! Special Education Teachers: 1 teacher for every 22 inclusion students
- ! Special Education TAs: 1 TA for every 30 inclusion students

Special Education "Units": During intersession weeks, special education units, such as Total Communication (TC) will be staffed as they are during the regular school day.

Other Special Education Services: Specific special education services like Occupational Therapy (OT), Physical Therapy (PT), etc. may be provided depending on which staff choose to work intersession weeks, but are not guaranteed during intersession.
