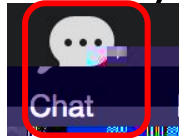

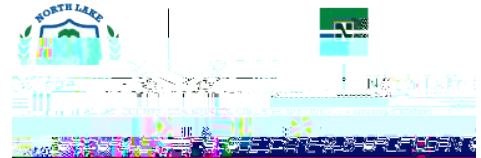

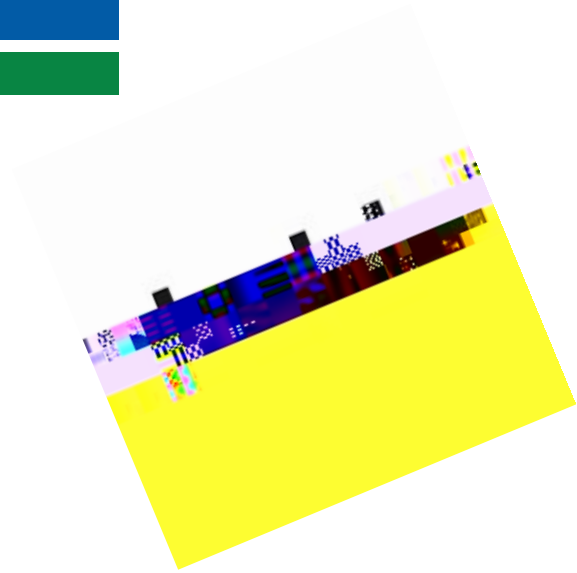

Racial equity, ending systemic racism, and eliminating the opportunity, learning, and achievement gap that currently exists for many students of color in Dallas ISD.

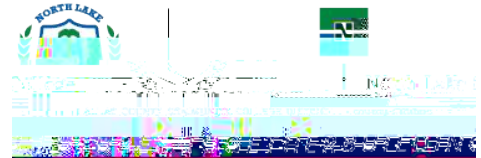

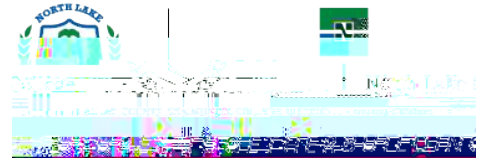
Live instruction will take place during each period

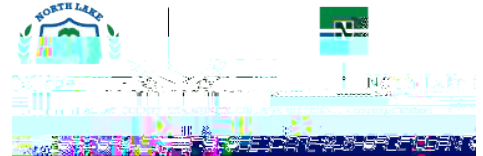
