



Resolution to Designate all Dallas Independent School District Schools as Welcoming and Protective TO THE FULLEST EXTENT OF THE LAW

WHEREAS, The Dallas Independent School District Board of Trustees embraces the diversity of our students and families and the rich language and cultural assets they bring to our District and strongly supports and encourages the participation of all parents and families in our schools; and

WHEREAS, the Dallas Independent School District Board of Trustees is committed to following the law and providing a high quality education to all students regardless of their immigration status, ethnicity, national origin, language, race, religion, sexual orientation, gender, gender identity, disability, or socioeconomic status; and

WHEREAS, the Dallas Independent School District is committed to providing a learning environment that facilitates the physical safety and emotional well-being of all students; and

WHEREAS, the Dallas Independent School District has adopted policies that prohibit discrimination, including harassment, against any student on any basis protected by law that creates an intimidating, threatening, hostile, or offensive educational environment (FFH (LOCAL)); and

WHEREAS, in order to provide school environments that are as conducive to learning as possible every Dallas Independent School District campus must be designated as Welcoming and Protective of all students and their families to the fullest extent of the law.
