The Dallas Independent School District's Sports Medicine is comprised of Athletic Trainers who are recognized by the American Medical Association as an Allied Healthcare Professional; the Licensed Athletic Trainer is a well-trained professional and an integral part of the complete athletic program. The role of the Licensed Athletic Trainer includes prevention, treatment, and rehabilitation of athletic injuries as well as education and counseling of athletes. A Licensed Athletic Trainer has a thorough knowledge of anatomy, physiology, psychology, nutrition, conditioning and other related areas.

The Dallas ISD Sports Medicine staff is pleased to work in conjunction with multiple physicians, whose specialty is in the area of sports medicine, to assist you in facilitating the most appropriate care for your child. As a parent/guardian of a student athlete in the Dallas ISD I understand that injuries can sometimes occur. If my child has an injury or illness, I do hereby request, authorize and consent to providing immediate care and treatment to my child by any physician, athletic trainer, healthcare provider or school representative caring for my child at the time of injury or illness.

ATHLETIC INSURANCE ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

Dallas Independent School District's (Dallas ISD) Athletic Department provides a student accident insurance policy for those students who participate in UIL activities. The policy is \$25,000 basic and a \$6,000,000 catastrophic athletic accident insurance policy. The premium for these policies is paid by Dallas ISD; there is no cost to you as a parent. This coverage acts as a supplement (secondary) to any coverage that you may have. The individual's insurance coverage is primary. Once your primary insurance has paid, then the remaining expenses, up to the maximum benefits allowed, maybe paid by the supplement policy. If the individual does not have primary insurance coverage, the school insurance will only pay the maximum benefits allowed. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian and student to notify the D
